



4 NOTES TO THE ESTIMATED STATEMENT OF AFFAIRS AS AT 26 JANUARY 2015

Assets

Assets Specifically Pledged.

4.1 Rent Deposit

The Directors advise that when the Company entered into the lease of the trading premises at 7 Park Industrial Estate, Frogmore, St Albans, Herts AL2 2DR it was required to provide a rent deposit of £6,750, which was equivalent to 3 months rent. As at the cessation of trade, there were no rental arrears and the bond had not been called upon. The lease however expires in September 2015 and the landlord could therefore potentially have a claim of £13,500 rent or dilapidations, which they would claim against the bond. For the sake of prudence the bond has been shown in the Statement of Affairs as not being realisable for the benefit of the liquidation.

Assets not Specifically Pledged

4.2 Tangible Fixed Assets

The accounts to 31 March 2014 show the Company holding Tangible Fixed Assets with a Net Book Value of £1,615. The same comprised of two electric forklifts, racking, computer equipment together with office furniture and equipment.

Adam Costigan of Realise Solutions (UK) Limited, who is qualified by experience, valued these assets with a forced sale value of £1,175.00.

4.3 Stocks

The accounts to 31 March 2014 showed the Company holding stocks with a Net Book Value of £212. The Directors advise that, as at the cessation of trade, all of the stock held at the trading premises was held on a consignment basis, and therefore, does not belong to the Company and has no realisable value for the benefit of Company. Accordingly, arrangements will be made for the suppliers to collect their stock following the liquidation of the Company and the appointment of Liquidators.

4.4 Debtors

The Directors advise that as at the cessation of trade, the Company had debtors totaling £22,067 (inclusive of VAT), which comprised of two debtors, Humax Electronics Co Ltd and YouView Ltd. Invoices have been raised for the work completed prior to the liquidation and it is envisaged that these debts will be collected in full, however, for the sake of prudence in this Statement of Affairs, these debts have been written down by 15%.

The Directors advise the Company is also due monies from a third company, however this debtor is also listed as a creditor of the Company, therefore it is envisaged that the debt will be offset. Therefore for the purposes of this Statement of Affairs, the balance has not been included in the figures above.

4.5 Cash at Bank

As at the cessation of trade the Company's bank accounts with Natwest Bank Plc held credit balances totaling £51,826.44

The Company also holds an account with PayPal which currently has a credit balance of £40.52

4.6 Cash in Hand

The Company had petty cash of £47.48, which has been paid to the Nominated Liquidators and is being held in a designated account.

Creditors

4.7 Preferential Creditors

It is estimated that there will be claims from the former employees of the Company in respect of outstanding wages and holiday pay. Any claims in this regard will constitute preferential claims.

4.8 HM Revenue & Customs

The Directors estimate that a total of £19,639.81 is owed to HM Revenue & Customs in regards to VAT for the period to November 2014.

It is envisaged that a further amount may be due to HMRC in respect of the final period of trading however it is not possible to quantify this at present.

A further £3,776.84 is owed to them in relation to PAYE & NIC for the period to December 2014.

The Directors also estimate that £11,639 20 will be owed to HM Revenue & Customs in relation to a Corporation Tax

4.9 Trade and Expense Creditors

The amounts stated in the statement of affairs have been supplied by the director who believes that these creditors have outstanding monies owed to them. The figure detailed in the estimated Statement of Affairs is subject to the agreement of creditors' claims. Creditors' amounts include VAT where applicable.

4.10 Inter-company Trading

This represents the trading position between the Company and an associated Company, CWNetworks Limited. The Company charged CWNetworks Limited for goods and services provided together management fees, and itself was charge for goods and services received.

This company is connected pursuant to Section 435 of The Insolvency Act 1986 (as amended), by virtue of shared Directors and shareholders.

4.11 Landlord

See note 4.1 above

4.12 Employee Claims

This represents the estimated liabilities in respect of redundancy and pay in lieu of notice due to the employees of the Company.

4.13 General

The estimated Statement of Affairs is subject to the Joint Liquidators' costs and disbursements and the costs of the agents and solicitors employed by the Liquidators'.

The figures detailed in the estimated statement of affairs are subject to the agreement of creditor claims.

Unless otherwise stated, all agents instructed are independent and have no connection to the insolvent party/ (ies), the (nominated) office holder(s) or Beesley Corporate Solutions.

Two suppliers have advised that they hold stock at the trading premises which is on a consignment basis. Both creditors have been granted access to the trading premises to identify their stock, and arrangements will be made following the appointment of the Liquidators for these suppliers to collect same.
