Note 1

In the accounts ended 31 March 2009 there were tangible assets of £11,097. This amount included plant & machinery, fixtures and fittings, a motor vehicle, and computer equipment.

Plant & Machinery

At the time that the accounts were prepared the company had a generator, cement mixer, and welder. The scaffolding and generator were exchanged with an associate for a scaffolding tower of the same value to allow the company to undertake appropriate contracts. Since this time the scaffolding tower became unsafe and was scrapped. From this point the company subcontracted scaffolding and did not replace the same. The cement mixer broke down due to wear and tear and was scrapped. The company found it more cost effective to hire a cement mixer when appropriate.

Fixtures and Fittings

The only fixtures and fittings that the company owned was a fax machine, which broke down and was scrapped due to being beyond repair. The company did not replace the fax machine.

Motor vehicle

The company leased a Land Rover motor vehicle from a local garage, however this was returned to the garage from which it was purchased in February 2011. The depreciated vehicle met the outstanding balance of the vehicle.

Computer equipment

The company owned a desktop computer which operated on the Windows 97 operating system. Over time and as the computer could not be upgraded in order to operate on a more updated system, the computer broke down with the cost of repair being more than the cost of the computer. This computer was scrapped and the company continued to trade using a laptop owned by a third party.

Note 2

The Director has made the Insolvency Group aware that approximately £8,000 is outstanding to ASL Construction Limited, but that this amount represents mainly bad debts and therefore the amount that could be realised is minimal, but the Director has estimated that approximately £3,000 is realisable. The Director is to make the invoices available to the Insolvency Group in order to request payment.


