



- 5 **HM Revenue & Customs (PAYE/NIC)** The debt due to HM Revenue & Customs is in respect of unpaid deductions of PAYE and National Insurance Contributions outstanding for the last two months of trading
- 6 **HM Revenue & Customs (VAT)** The debt due to HM Revenue & Customs is in respect of outstanding VAT for the last six months of trading
- 7 **Barclays Bank Plc** The company banked with Barclays Bank Plc, 93 Lewisham High Street, London, SE13 6BB, and utilised the facilities provided by the Bank. The Bank holds no security for its lending


