- 3 The equipment and fixtures & fittings from the former trading premises have been inspected and valued by Gilbert Baitson, auctioneers and valuers of Hull. They have negotiated a sale and hold the proceeds of sale
- 4 The inclusion of creditor balances on the statement of affairs is as per the company's records. Historically the directors have loaned the company monies to assist cash flow, the amount currently owing to them has not been quantified. Claims of creditors will be subject to admission by the duly appointed liquidator in the usual way
